

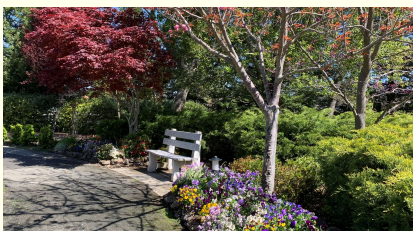
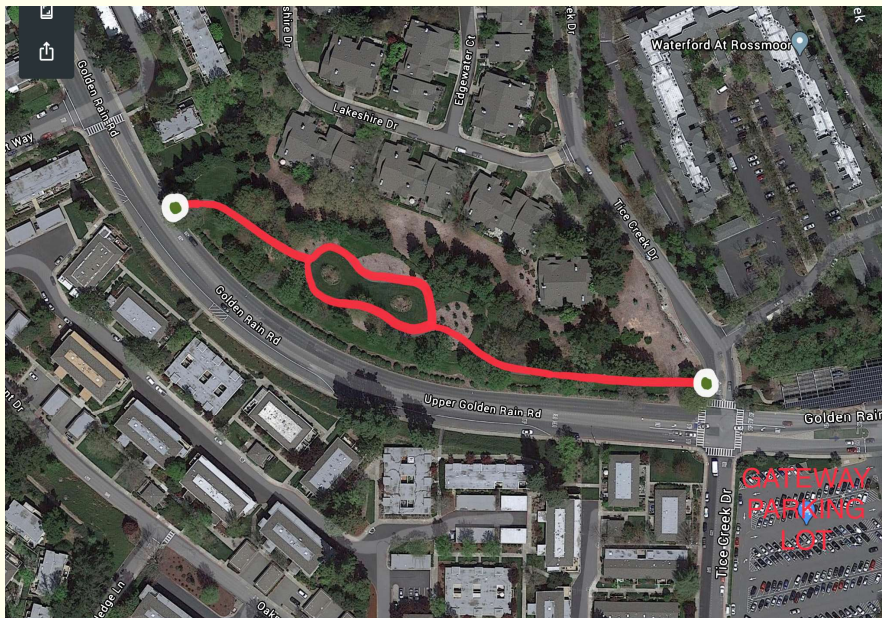
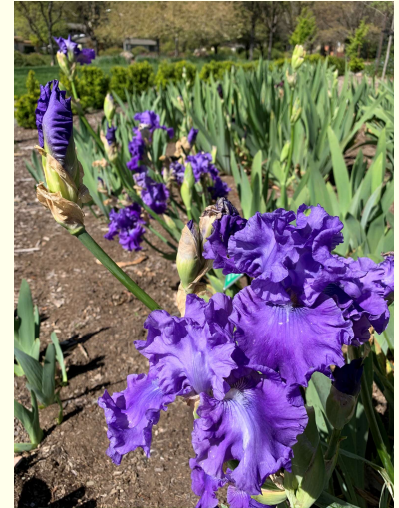


Iris Park Walking Trail

Trail through 'IRIS PARK'. Dedication benches to rest on and enjoy the flowers, and an Iris test garden best visited in May.

Access to the park is difficult, as you must cross the road to get there. Parking is available either in Gateway Parking lot or along Golden Rain Road but be careful crossing this busy street and be sure to use the crosswalk.

If entering from Golden Rain Road look for the trail just south of entry one. If accessing from Tice Creek, look for the trail near the NW intersection of Tice Creek and Golden Rain Rd.



Length: 0.4 Miles

Difficulty: Easy

Location: Spans between the intersection of Tice Creek and Golden Rain Road to entry one, Golden Rain Rd.

Parking: Along Golden Rain Road on South side of street or in Gateway Parking Lot
